Spring 2022 incomplete grades are now due by August 2022.

Policy change relating to transfer credit from other institutions with Pass/Fail (P/F) policies:

Current Policy states that we do not accept courses completed or Failed as transfer credit. Courses cannot be retaken. Courses completed or Failed at other institutions are not accepted for credit. Courses completed in Spring 2022 at an institution so that a student can transfer are not accepted for credit. Policy change relating to final exams:

Students are permitted to request a final exam change on a course to a higher level upon the student and instructor's agreement. Final exam change requests do not need to go through the Provost's office. Spring 2022 semester's policies do not affect the requirement that students are permitted to request a final exam change.
